91 Anselmet Valle d'Aosta Torrette Superieur 2014 \$42 Gorgeous cherry and strawberry fruit notes define this intense red, which is light-footed despite the concentration, with vibrant acidity and fine-grained tannins. Drink now through 2020. 1,000 cases made.—J.S.

91 Antonelli Montefalco Sagrantino 2010 \$44 Very elegant, this is surprisingly accessible for a young Sagrantino, with sculpted tannins deftly knit to flavors of black currant, tarry mineral, herbes de Provence and singed orange peel. Velvety on the palate, with a long, licorice drop-ringed finish. From Umbria. Drink now through 2025. 2,850 cases made.—A.N.

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87 Tenute Sella & Mosca Vermentino di Sardegna La Cala 2015 \$14 A snappy white, with fleshy mix of yellow plum, kiwifruit, sliced almond and orange zest, backed by lively acidity. Stone and spice notes show on the crisp finish. Drink now. 39,500 cases made.—A.N.

87 Setterè Orvieto Classico 2015 \$12 A well-knit and balanced white, with a fleshy mix of apple, almond skin, ground spice and honeysuckle notes, layered with lightly tangy acidity. From Umbria. Drink now. 25,000 cases made.—A.N.

86 Cleto Chiarli e Figli Lambrusco Grasparossa di Castelvetro Amabile Centenario NV \$17 A crowd-pleasing Lambrusco, with juicy acidity complementing the easy-drinking mix of ripe and candied black cherry and raspberry fruit, accented by spice and citrus
